The Marie Curie Conference, lasting a day and a half prior to the main ESOF2008 conference (http://www.esof2008.org) will offer fellows special opportunities to broaden their career perspectives and further exploit their potential as Marie Curie Fellows.

Details about the participation

The number of places available at the conference is limited. Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. At registration, fellows will be requested to submit an abstract for a poster or an oral presentation on the themes of the conference:

- fostering creative collaborations with other scientific fields
- convince politics to fund your research
- best practice in dissemination
- exploiting your research results with the private sector

Posters will not be regular scientific posters but should reflect the capacity of the fellow to sell her/his own research to scientists from other fields and to policy makers, or be an example of best practice in private/academic collaboration, and/or in public dissemination.

Selection of the abstracts for oral presentations will be made by the organisers on the basis of its quality and creativity.
